



Senate Order for Entity Contracts: Listing for the period 1 July 2017 to 30 June 2018

Pursuant to the Senate Order for Entity Contracts, the following table sets out contracts entered into by the Department of Communications and the Arts which provide for a consideration to the value of \$100,000 or more (GST inclusive) and which have:

- not been fully performed as at 30 June 2018, or
- been entered into during the 12 months prior to 30 June 2018.

Most of the contracts listed contain confidentiality provisions of a general nature that are designed to protect the confidential information of the parties that may be obtained or generated in carrying out the contract.

The reasons for including such clauses include:

- ordinary commercial prudence that requires protection of trade secrets, proprietary information and the like; and/or
- protection of other Commonwealth material and personal information.

Where the department has agreed that specific matters associated with a contractual arrangement are to be treated as confidential, this is indicated in the listing.

The accountable authority of the Department of Communications and the Arts has assured that the listed contracts do not contain any inappropriate confidentiality provisions.
